We wanted to give you an update on Rev. Roger's condition.

On Sunday June 13th, Roger had a right brain stroke while getting ready to come to church. This type of stroke has excellent potential for recovery. He was fast tracked to National Rehabilitation Hospital for aggressive therapy because he is an excellent candidate for rehab. He is scheduled to be there for 3-4 weeks. His prognosis is good and he is expected to make a full recovery.

He is working hard in rehab (3 hours a day, 6 days a week). It is pretty demanding and he needs to conserve his energy and strength. We will let you know when he is ready for calls and visits. If you wish to send cards, please send them to the church and we will make sure he gets them.

Barbara will keep us informed as to his progress and we will relay that information to you when we receive it. Thank you for your continued support and prayers for his healing. We invite you to join us in this prayer: *As we open our hearts and minds to the presence of God, we see the divine being that is Roger. We see the Light of God in him and know all is well.*

This is a challenging time for our ministry and we can honor Roger by using it as an opportunity to put into practice some of what he's been teaching us for the last few years. Roger holds this ministry as a divine expression of Spirit. Let's join together to support Roger, each other and our ministry.

While Roger is recovering we plan to bring in some great guest speakers. Since the summertime is vacation time for many members we don't usually budget for this.
